



The ACTION Study



A randomized Phase 3 study of ONC201 (dordaviprone) in patients with newly diagnosed H3 K27M-mutant diffuse glioma



- The H3 K27M mutation occurs in both pediatric and adult patients with glioma^{1,2}
- ONC201, a first-in-class imipridone, is a selective small molecule antagonist of DRD2 and agonist of CIpP
- Phase 2 data demonstrated a 30% ORR by combined RANO HGG/LGG criteria with ONC201 in recurrent, H3 K27M-mutant glioma³⁻⁵

The ACTION study (NCT05580562) is a randomized, double-blind, placebo-controlled, parallel-group international Phase 3 trial of patients with newly diagnosed, H3 K27M diffuse glioma after completion of radiotherapy.

Eligibility Criteria

- · H3 K27M-mutant diffuse glioma
- H3 K27M mutation by IHC or NGS
- . ≥10 kg body weight
- · 2-6 weeks since radiotherapy
- KPS/LPS ≥70
- Stable or decreasing corticosteroids and anti-seizure medication for seven days
- Not eligible: Spinal tumors, DIPG, leptomeningeal spread, CSF dissemination

1:1:1 Randomization (2-6 weeks post RT)

(625 mg)

Eligibility will not be restricted based on age, provided patients are ≥10 kg. Patients ≤52.5 kg will receive a dose scaled by body weight.

Primary Outcomes Efficacy: OS, PFS

Secondary Outcomes

Safety: AE incidence, change from baseline

Efficacy: PFS in patients with measurable, contrast-enhancing disease Clinical benefit: Corticosteroid response,

performance status response

QoL: EORTC-QLQ-C30, QLQ-BN20, MDASI-BT,

PedsQL, NANO

Planned Screening: 480 patients
Planned Enrollment: 450 patients

Analyses:

- Interim: 50% OS events (164 deaths), 75%OS events (246 deaths)
- Final: 327 OS events, 286 PFS events

Study Sites: -120 sites planned in 15 countries

Study Status:

- ACTION is enrolling at more than 100 centers throughout the USA, Europe, Israel, and Asia-Pacific, with additional sites planned.

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




